CENTRAL COVENTRY FIRE DISTRICT Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors December 14, 2022 @ 6:30 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Pullano at 6:30 p.m. District Clerk Kaplan took a roll call to determine if a quorum was present. Those in attendance were President Pullano, Vice President McGillivray, Director Santilli, Director Lavallee, Chief Brown, and District Clerk Kaplan. Directors Polselli, Benoit, and Mattson were excused. President Pullano led the Pledge of Allegiance and gave directions for emergency exit.

A motion to approve the Meeting Minutes from November 17, 2022, was made by Vice President McGillivray, seconded by Director Lavallee, and unanimously approved.

The Fire Chief's report was presented by Chief of Department Frank Brown. He thanked the firefighters for all that they do daily. A motion to approve the report was made by Vice President McGillivray, seconded by Director Santilli, and unanimously approved.

A motion to approve District Treasurer Civetti's Monthly Financial Report read by President Pullano, was made by Vice President McGillivray, seconded by Director Santilli, and unanimously approved.

A motion to approve District Clerk Kaplan's report was made by Director Santilli, seconded by Vice President McGillivray, and unanimously approved.

Public comments from Councilman John Pascua:

- A resolution by the Town Council to appoint a Public Safety Commission
- An RFP for public safety study for consolidation of the fire districts in the Town
- A public education component to educate the public about the importance of a consolidated and fully functional fire district.

Under Old Business Chief Brown explained that PRISIM was going to separate the streetlights in the Anthony District from those in the CCFD.

A motion to approve the Chief's applying for a SAFER grant to fund the hiring of 15 new firefighters was made by Vice President McGillivray, seconded by Director Lavallee and unanimously approved.

APRA funds distribution by the Town Council will probably take place at their January 2023 meeting.

Chief Brown said that a hiring list had been posted and would start the interview process by February 2023.

Under New Business:

Director Lavallee will contact Senator Raptakis, Coventry Town Council members and Coventry Town Manager about the monies owed to the District by the Coventry Pines Golf Course.

A motion to look at the feasibility of a merger/consolidation of the Fire Districts in the Town of Coventry was made by Director Santilli, seconded by Director Lavallee, and unanimously approved.

A motion to allow the president to seek fiscal borrowing of a TAN/or short-term line of credit that can be collateralized against CCFD Owned real property was made by Vice President McGillivray, seconded by Director Lavallee, and unanimously approved.

A motion allowing District Treasurer Civetti to work with Director Santilli, Director Benoit, and Chief Brown to devise a budget that will include a capital improvement fund for depreciated assets and real property maintenance to be able to meet our fiscal needs in 2023 and be used to discuss a special tax rate increase to be voted on by the qualified taxpayers was made by Vice President McGillivray, seconded by Director Lavallee, and unanimously approved.

A motion to accept Director Carl Matteson's resignation from the Board of Directors of CCFD and to discuss candidates to appoint temporarily for 60 days (or the duration set forth in CCFD by-laws), until a special election can take place, was made by Vice President McGillivray, seconded by Director Lavallee, and unanimously approved. Debbie McAllister said she would be available to fill the position.

A motion to approve the abatements was made by Vice President McGillivray, seconded by Director Santilli, and unanimously approved.

A motion to convene into Executive Session was made by Vice President McGillivray, seconded by Director Santilli, and unanimously approved.

A motion to close the Executive Session and seal the minutes of the Executive Session pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-46-4(b) was made by Vice President McGillivray, seconded by Director Santilli, and unanimously approved by roll-call vote.

A motion to Reconvene to Open Session and report any votes/actions taken in Executive Session was made by Vice President McGillivray, seconded

by Director Santilli, and unanimously approved. There were no votes taken in the Executive Session.

A motion to adjourn was made by Vice President McGillivray, seconded by Director Santilli, and unanimously approved. The meeting was adjourned at 9:15PM

Summary of Operation activities:

PERSONNEL

Currently we have 24 members on staff and 3 members out on injury. One firefighter resigned on January 10, 2023

TOTAL PERSONNEL – 27

Applications for a hiring eligibility list has been posted and will close on February 1, 2023. As of January 14, 2023 there were 17 applications submitted.

EMERGENCY INCIDENTS

* Incidents from January 1, 2022 thru December 31, 2022 were 4457 for a call volume of 13 calls per day. (see attached summary) Coventry Fire Alarm recorded a total of 6753 incidents at year end.

APPARATUS

- *Rescue 4 is currently OOS at Tasca. A new engine has been ordered with an expected delivery date the first week of February. Return date is still unknown at this time.
- *Engine 7 had a complete brake job.
- *Rescue 7 is having engine regen issues. Tasca advises the diesel particulate exhaust system will need to be replaced ASAP when parts be come available, possible end of February.
