The meeting was called to order by President Gralinski at 7:00 PM. A quorum was present consisting of: President Fred Gralinski, Vice President Cindy Fagan-Perry, Directors Richard Polselli, Carl Mattson, James Kuipers, Kristen Benoit and Russell McGillivray, District Manager Corrigan, Legal Counsel David D'Agostino, Esq., of Gorham & Gorham, Inc., Chief Brown, and District Clerk Kaplan were present. Finance Manager Dykeman was excused. President Gralinski led the Pledge of Allegiance, safety instructions for exiting the room, and took a roll call.

A declaration of a quorum was stated by President Gralinski.

District Manager Corrigan read and explained the report on receipts and disbursements from for the Fiscal Year recently ended. A motion to approve was made by Director McGillivray, seconded by Vice President Fagan-Perry and unanimously approved.

A motion to approve the resolution to set the tax rate based on approval of 8.5% budget increase provided the same is passed by the voters, otherwise the Board will approve a tax rate based on RIGL § 45-2-3.2 (a) that provides the same amounts approved in the previous FY shall be available was made by Director Mattson, seconded by Director Polselli and unanimously approved.

A motion to adjourn at 7:30, subject to ballot count results, was made by Director Mattson, seconded by Director Polselli and unanimously approved.

At 9:00PM the results of the ballot count were announced. The tax rate increase was defeated with 961 votes against the increase and 272 votes in favor of the increase.

The vote count for the election of two Board Member seats is as follows: Debbie Santilli 508 votes Carl Mattson 493 votes Bradford Mayer 263 votes Lareto Guglietta 195 votes

The meeting was called to order by President Gralinski at 6:30 PM. A quorum was present consisting of: President Fred Gralinski, Vice President Cindy Fagan-Perry, Directors Richard Polselli, Carl Mattson, James Kuipers, and Russell McGillivray, Legal Counsel David D'Agostino, Esq., of Gorham & Gorham, Inc., Chief Brown, and District Clerk Kaplan were present. Director Kristen Benoit and District Manager Corrigan were excused. Chief Brown led the Pledge of Allegiance, and President Gralinski gave safety instructions, and took a roll call.

A motion to approve the meeting minutes from July 15, 2021, was made by Vice President Fagan-Perry with the stipulation that the date of the July meeting minutes on the agenda be corrected, seconded by Director Polselli and unanimously approved.

A motion to approve the meeting minutes from August 02, 2021, was made by Director Mattson, seconded by Vice President Fagan-Perry and unanimously approved.

A motion to approve the meeting minutes from August 03, 2021, was made by Vice President Fagan-Perry, seconded by Director Kuipers and unanimously approved.

The Chief's Report was read into the record noting that Engines 4 and 7 were out of service with engine problems covered by warranty. A motion to approve the report was made by Director Kuipers, seconded by Director McGilivray, and unanimously approved.

The Financial Reports were read by President Gralinski. A motion to approve the reports was made by Director Polselli, seconded by Vice President Fagan-Perry, and unanimously approved.

The District Clerk's report was read by Mr. Kaplan. The Tax Report included a fiscal year-to-date summation, as well as the monthly collections. Director McGillivray asked for a clarification of the FY 2020 outstanding taxes. A motion to approve the report was made by Director McGillivray, seconded by Vice President Fagan-Perry, and unanimously approved.

New Business:

A motion to approve the Resolution 2021-14, to appoint Nadeau-Wadovick, LLP (and Jeffrey D. Wadovick, CPA) as District Treasurer for an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00 for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 was made by Vice President Fagan-Perry, seconded by Director Mattson and unanimously approved

A motion to approve the Resolution 2021-15, to appoint and employ Daniel Kaplan as District Clerk, effective September 1, 2021, under the terms and conditions of said Resolution was made by Vice President Fagan-Perry, seconded by Director Mattson and unanimously approved. Director McGillivray asked if the appointment should be advertised but was told by Legal Counsel D'Agostino that the board had the right under its Charter to appoint and employ a District Clerk.

A motion to approve Resolution 2021-18, to retain District Legal Counsel, Gorham & Gorham, Inc. as Litigation Counsel in the matter, <u>Almagno v. CCFD</u>, 20-440-JJM-LDA was made by, Vice President Fagan-Perry, seconded by Director Mattson and unanimously approved.

A motion to approve Resolution 2021-19, to retain District Legal Counsel, Gorham & Gorham, Inc. as Litigation Counsel in the matter, <u>RIDLT v. CCFD</u>, File No.: 2020-0296 was made by Director Mattson, seconded by Director Kuipers and unanimously approved.

A motion to approve Resolution 2021-20, to Appeal any Ruling Adverse to the Central Coventry Fire District in the matter, <u>RIDLT v. CCFD</u>, File No.: 2020-0296 and as further set forth in said Resolution was made by Vice President Fagan-Perry, seconded by Director Mattson and passed with Directors Kuipers and McGillivray opposed.

Summary of Operation activities:

#### **PERSONNEL**

Currently we have 25 members on staff and 6 members out on injury. 1 Probationary Firefighter at the Municipal Fire Academy will graduate on November 19<sup>th</sup>.

Assistant Chief Mark Blanding officially retired on October 1<sup>st</sup>. His career spanned over 25 years. We wish him a safe and healthy retirement.

**TOTAL PERSONNEL - 31** 

#### **EMERGENCY INCIDENTS**

- \* Incidents from January 1, 2021 thru September 30, 2021 were 3384 for a call volume of 13 calls per day. (see attached summary)
- \*On the morning of September 18<sup>th</sup> crews from CCFD, WCFD, HHFD, AFD and Hianloland handled a working dwelling fire. But the HERO of that day was 8yo Nicholas who lives across the street. When he heard a smoke alarm going off he looked out his bedroom window and saw smoke coming from the house. He notified is parents who sprang into action. His Dad attempted to put the fire out with a portable extinguisher while his Mom was banging on the front door and then entered to wake a resident in house and get him to safety. If it wasn't for Nicholas's quick actions the outcome would most likely have been different.

#### OFFICE of the CHIEF of DEPARTMENT

#### **APPARATUS**

- \*Engine 4 is in service but has an "check engine light" light. The fault code indicates a VGT Actuator issue which is the engine turbo. Estimated repair is \$3,643.42 once Cummins finds the root cause they will know if its covered under warranty or billable.
- \*During annual fire pump testing Engine 4 had a couple of minor issues what will need to addressed in the near future. Engine 5 had a leaking discharge manifold that was repaired. Both Engines passed testing and are certified for the next year.
- \*Engine 7 remains out of service. Cummins will be replacing the engine. Which will be covered under warranty.
- \* Marine 7 is now out of Johnsons Pond.
- \*On September 17<sup>th</sup> at approximately 8PM Rescue 7 was transporting to KCMH with lights and siren on when a vehicle crossed the center line of the roadway and struck the rescue on driver side of the vehicle. Both the Driver, Officer and patient were not injured. The vehicle that hit the rescue left the scene but was later found by the CPD. Driver was charged with several motor vehicle violations.

#### **EQUIPMENT**

\*All portable equipment is up and running properly at this time.

#### **STATIONS**

On October 8<sup>th</sup> I was notified of a burst pipe on the well pump at Station 7. I had a plumber come out within a few hours and make the needed repairs and restore water service to the station. I've been advised by him that a lot of the piping is suspect to future failure due to corrosion and under size wall thickness.


