CENTRAL COVENTRY FIRE DISTRICT Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors November 17, 2022 @ 6:30 P. M.

The meeting was called to order by President Pullano at 6:30 p.m. District Clerk Kaplan took a roll call to determine if a quorum was present. Those in attendance were President Pullano, Vice President McGillivray, Director Mattson, Director Benoit, Director Santilli, Director Lavallee, District Treasurer Civetti, Chief Brown, and District Clerk Kaplan. Director Polselli was excused. President Pullano led the Pledge of Allegiance and gave directions for emergency exit.

A motion to approve the suggestions for CAPA (Corrective Actions/Preventative Actions) and RCA (Root Cause Analysis) investigations by Sinclair Risk and Financial Management (Joseph F. Pinto and his team) to lower insurance premiums was made by Director Santilli, seconded by Director Mattson, and unanimously approved.

A motion to approve the Meeting Minutes from November 03, 2022, was made by Director Benoit, seconded by Director Lavallee, and approved. Director Mattson abstained as he was not at the November 03, 2022, meeting.

The Fire Chief's report was presented by Chief of Department Frank Brown. He noted that a recent on the job injury was resolved within 24 hours by our new carrier which permitted the firefighter involved to get doctor visits and physical therapy and get him back on the job sooner. A motion to approve the report was made by Director Mattson, seconded by Vice President McGillivray, and unanimously approved.

A motion to approve District Treasurer Civetti's Monthly Financial Report was made by Vice President McGillivray, seconded by Director Mattson, and unanimously approved.

A motion to approve District Clerk Kaplan's report was made by Vice President McGillivray, seconded by Director Mattson, and unanimously approved.

A motion to establish a hiring list was made by Director Benoit, seconded by Director Lavallee, and unanimously approved.

A discussion took place to have the Chief start an application for a (SAFER) Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response Grant Program.

Chief Brown explained that the process was labor intensive, but worth the undertaking.

A motion to approve holding future meetings of the Board of Directors at the Coventry Senior Center, 50 Wood Street was made by Vice President McGillivray, seconded by Director Lavallee, and unanimously approved.

A motion to approve Chief Brown and Treasurer Civetti to choose a vendor for payroll services and report back to the Board with their recommendation was made by Director Santilli, seconded by Director Mattson, and unanimously approved.

A discussion about setting a date for the Board to tour the CCFD facilities and inspect the equipment was tentatively set for January 21, 2023.

There were no public comments.

The next scheduled meeting will be December 14, 2022, at the Coventry Senior Center

A motion to adjourn was made by Director Mattson, seconded by Vice President McGillivray, and unanimously approved. The meeting was adjourned at 8:11PM.
